ARA RESSURECTED

Sometime, during pre-Christian era, there was a cult of a demigod figure named *Ara* (also known as Ara the Handsome or Ara the Beautiful) who was known to have died and been resurrected.

This song is dedicated to the Velvet Revolution that happened in Armenia in the spring of 2018.

DREAM VOYAGER

This song is dedicated to my father who has an ability to see places in his dreams where he has never been before. Every once in a while, he visits these places following the memory of the details of his dreams.

VORTEX

The character \not{E} (=Latin E) is the seventh letter of the Armenian alphabet, and it corresponds to the word Essence [éutiun]. This letter represents the 'essence of life'. Like the essence of life, this piece is in a constant motion represented by a vortex rotating in cycles of large and small sevens.

THE 37 NEWLYWEDS

C Minor Solo

This song is dedicated to 37 Armenian newlywed couples from 37 villages who, in 1918, put on black tunics, marked their foreheads red, got on their white horses, and rode into the battle to fight the Ottoman army.

I have taken the lyrics from two different folk songs and composed a new melody for them.

The cold wind blew from the mountain, I am burning, burning, *Turning into a bright fire. It has turned clouded as if arch after arch, I will die for you.*

NEW MAPS

New Maps represents the present and the future, the search and the attempts of understanding the map of our universe, of our planet and us, as well as the maps to which we are constantly adapting while carrying with us the aura of the past.

New Maps also represents the humans in the technological and spiritual progress, constantly rediscovering while being on the expedition to the unknown where we have to make decisions that will shape our future human story.

THE CALL WITHIN

Composed and produced by Tigran Hamasyan, his new album **The Call Within** is an epic journey into the invisible inner world of the artist who despite having a physical body is living in a dreamlike inner world which is as realistic as the physical one. The artist lives in the world where the moment of the unconscious creation is the way to feel conscious.

As the artist states, "Unutterable seconds of longing, subliminal realisation, and mostly joy fill the body as a work of art, a poem, or a melody is being born into this world for no apparent reason, but only for the humanity to discover what is invisible: the divine mystery."

The album also explores the artist's inspiration for maps from different time periods in history. It explores poetry, Christian and pre-Christian Armenian folk stories and legends, as well as astrology, geometry, ancient Armenian design, rock carvings, and cinematography. The album blends the lines between the historic reality and the imaginary world.

Consisting of 10 original compositions featuring Evan Marien on electric bass and Arthur Hnatek on drums,

The Call Within is probably the most energetic and high-intensity album of Hamasyan's all albums. It also features the special guest artist Tosin Abasi on the furious Armenian prog tune named "Vorttx", and it features Areni Agbabian and Artyom Manukyan on "Our Film".
